## ASK THE ADMISSION OFFICE STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS AND SUPPORT

**Find an organization or issue** that captures your current interests or piques new ones. When thinking about your next step, ask the following about services and resources available to help you navigate the transition...

### Research First

- College websites frequently include links to student organizations on their campuses.
- Most college websites offer information about a wide range of support services on campus.

### Ask the Admission Office

- Is enrolling a diverse student body part of your institution's mission?
- What student organizations on campus recognize and celebrate my interests (e.g., academic, cultural, service)?
- How can I connect with students to learn more about organizations (e.g., individualized tour, sit in on a class, fly-in program, overnight experience, shadow a student for a day)?
- What specific support services are available on campus for someone like me (e.g., mental health counseling, disability services, financial advice)?
