ASK THE ADMISSION OFFICE CAMPUS SAFETY

Being a member of a campus community means ensuring you **feel welcomed and safe**. Be sure to ask the following questions regarding your safety, comfort, and more to determine if this is a community you want to join...

Research First

- ❑ The Department of Education maintains a campus crime database containing information about the crime rates on all college campuses.

Ask the Admission Office

- ❑ Is your institution committed to keeping campus safe? Can you explain your policy for notifying the campus community when an incident occurs?
- ❑ After an incident occurs, how do administrators address it with the campus community?
- ❑ Is there a process to report discrimination?
- ❑ Are campus safety officials trained in cultural sensitivity?
